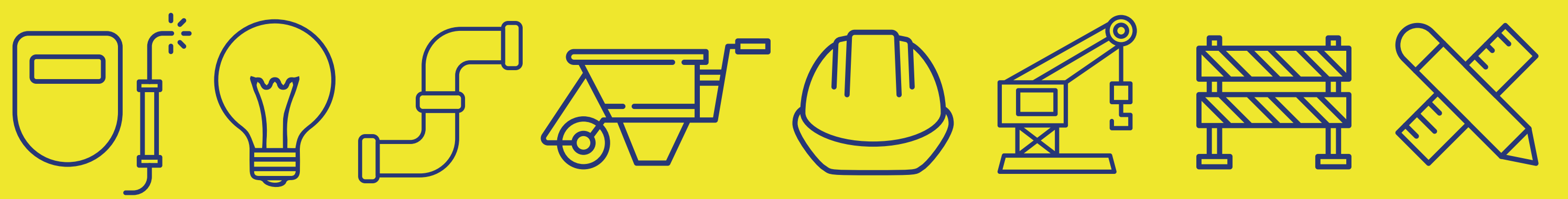

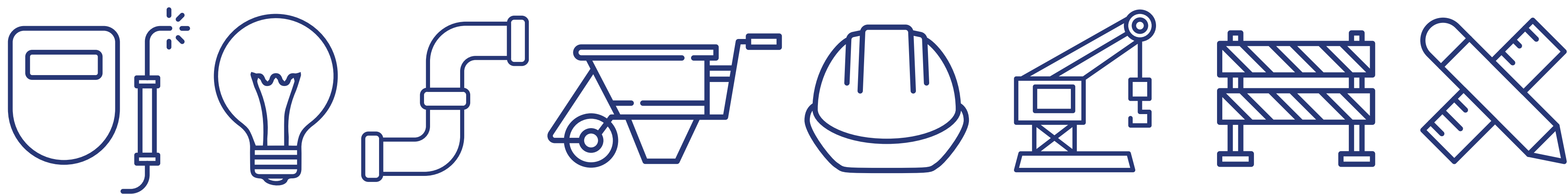

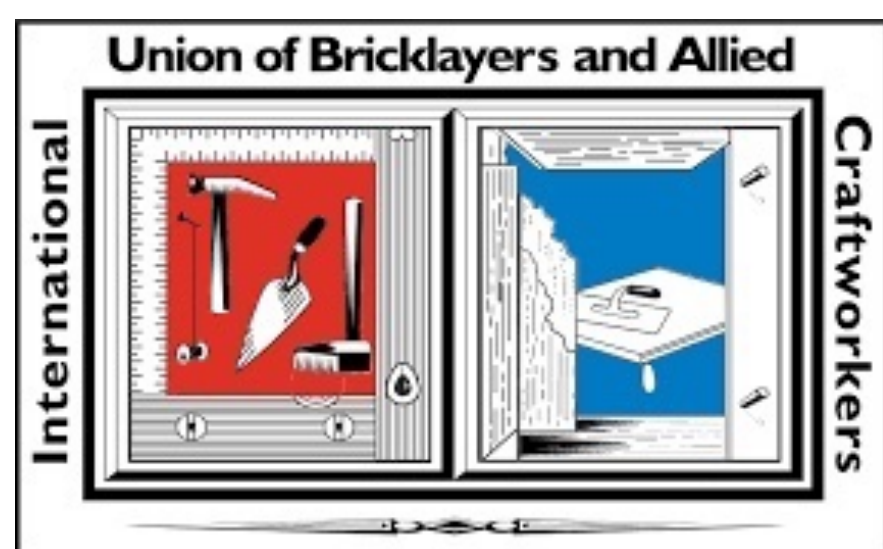
During apprenticeship, trainees will work a full time job with pay and benefits and attend a **tuition free** training program (not including associated costs of books, supplies and fees). Some programs offer college credit. This is a **union job** training program. Choosing a career in a union construction trade is a rewarding decisions; the work can be physically demanding but these are good jobs with **high wages, health insurance, pensions, benefits and workplace protections and power.** Earn a good living while also building structure that will stand as a proud monument to your labor for a lifetime.
